- 1. Good stable year for the Stroll of Poets, despite the pandemic. Overall revenue and expenses are lower overall.
- 2. We did finish the year with a year-over-year surplus of \$1300 and \$8000 surplus.
- 3. But we have expenses and bills coming up.
- 4. Main thing that helped us this past year was a very good response was a very good response to our call for donations: \$3127 which is \$1000 more than last year.
- 5. Especially received a very generous donation in memory of Diane Buchanan of \$1000.
- 6. Other revenue and expenses track pretty closely to the year before
- 7. \$5967 = grant money from EAC and AFA. Stabilizes our contract with WGA and the indispensable support of Ellen Kartz.
- 8. Statement doesn't show all the volunteer hours of so many couldn't put a dollar value on that.
